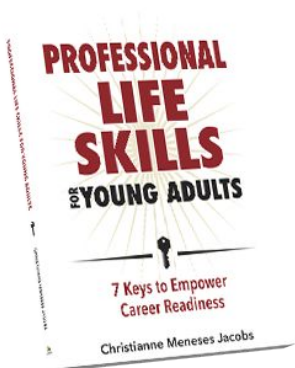


Christianne Meneses Jacobs
